## ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 36016, dated December 10, 1942, in the above entitled matter authorized Citizens Transit Company to suspend its passenger stage service within and between San Buenaventura and nearby points commencing December 15, 1942, and ending June 15, 1945, and to enter into two agreements with the City of San Buenaventura, a municipal corporation. One agreement covered the sale of four units of automotive equipment by Citizens Transit to the city, and the other agreement covered the lease of, with option to purchase, four additional units of equipment by Citizens Transit to the city.

Citizens Transit Company, by supplemental application, has expressed its desire that the Commission revoke the certificates of public convenience and necessity standing in its name.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

## IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificates of public convenience and necessity granted to or acquired by Citizens Transit Company pursuant to Decision No. 25792, dated April 3, 1933, Decision No. 25850, dated April 17, 1933, Decision No. 31592, dated December 27,

1938, Decisión No. 32332, dated September 19, 1939, and Decision No. 33578, dated October 8, 1940, are hereby cancelled, revoked and annulled.

(2) That all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Citizens Transit Company are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
