O R D E R

THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY and SOUTHERN
PACIFIC COMPANY are authorized to construct a spur track at grade
across Campbell Street in Oakland, Alameda County, at the location
described in the application. Campbell Street is not open or traveled
at the point of crossing and this order shall not be construed as
authorizing the opening of said street across said track. Applicant
shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order,
applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authoriza-
tion shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time
be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or
safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
