O R D E R

VISALIA ELECTRIC RAILROAD COMPANY has requested authority to abandon its non-agency station of Wirts, Tulare County, and to consolidate said station with its existing station of Rocky Hill located about one-quarter of a mile southerly on applicant's El Mirador Branch. No abandonment of facilities is proposed and existing facilities will be placed within the limits of Rocky Hill station. A principal user of the station at Wirts has stated in writing that it is in favor of the proposed change and California Farm Bureau has written the Commission that it has no objection to the abandonment of this station.

Good Cause Appearing, VISALIA ELECTRIC RAILROAD COMPANY is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Wirts, County of Tulare; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
