FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that paragraph 3 of the order in said Decision No. 38181 is hereby corrected to read as follows:

"Southern Cities Transit, Inc., may, after the effective date hereof and on or before May 15, 1946, issue to Guy C. Lyons and Etta Lyons, his wife, and Lawrence P. Goltra and Augusta W. Goltra, his wife, in part payment for said properties, its promissory note in the sum of Eighty-seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$87,500.00) Dollars and secure the payment of said note by the execution of a deed of trust and a chattel mortgage, said note, said deed of trust, and said mortgage of chattels to be in, or substantially in, the same form as the note, the deed of trust, and the mortgage of chattels on file in this application."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that paragraph 1 of the order in said Decision No. 38181 be, and the same is hereby, amended by substituting May 15, 1946, for October 1, 1945.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this nunc pro tunc order be deemed effective as of the same date as the order in said Decision No. 38181, dated August 28, 1945.
