O P I N I O N

Pacific Greyhound Lines by the above entitled application requests authority to use an additional route in Tracy and to consolidate such route with the remainder of its system.

Decision No. 23244, in Application No. 16989, (35 C.R.C. 677), authorized applicant, among other things, to serve Tracy and in so doing to operate upon U.S. Highway 50, which is designated in Tracy as 11th Street. Applicant's present depot is located on 11th Street between Adam and Center Streets. However, Pacific Greyhound Lines has developed plans for the construction of a new depot to be situated on 11th Street between Parker Avenue and Walnut Street. To enable it to gain access to the new depot when completed, the right is sought to use Parker Avenue between 11th and 12th Streets, and 12th Street between Parker Avenue and the driveway to the proposed depot.

The Commission has been advised by the City Clerk of Tracy that the City Council granted Pacific Greyhound Lines the right to use the streets in question.

The tariffs and time tables of applicant will not need to be changed if this application is granted, and other common carriers will not be affected. A public hearing is unnecessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Greyhound Lines is authorized to operate its passenger stage service in Tracy over and along Parker Avenue between 11th and 12th Streets, and over 12th Street between Parker Avenue and the driveway to its depot on 11th Street between Parker Avenue and Walnut Street as an extension and enlargement of, and consolidated with, the operative rights granted to it by Decision No. 23244, in Application No. 16989, as amended.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
