Jeannelle, doing business as San Joaquin Grain and Warehouse Company, operates a public utility warehouse at The warehouse is leased from R. C. Jeannelle Properties Turlocki Company; a corporation. Authority is sought to enable Jeannelle to sell a one-half interest in the business to Charles T. Valpey for a cash payment of \$307.50: The verified application states that Jeannelle and Valpey have been associated in a milling business for many years; that the consideration involved is equivalent to one-half of the value of equipment used in the warehouse business; that the owner of the warehouse proposes to lease the structure to Jeannelle and Valpey; and that no change in rates or service to the public is contemplated: It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted. Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ralph C. Jeannelle be and he is hereby authorized to sell a one-half interest in his public utility warehouse property, as described in this application, to Charles T, Valpey; that, concurrently with the commencement of warehouse -]-

operations at Turlock, Ralph C. Jeannelle and Charles T. Valpey shall file rates, rules and regulations identical with those now maintained by Ralph C. Jeannelle, in conformity with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61, and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public; and that R. C. Jeannelle Properties Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to lease the warehouse described in the application to Ralph C. Jeannelle and Charles T. Valpey, in accordance with the terms of the agreement attached to the application as Exhibit "A".

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
