OPINION AND ORDER

Producers Warehouse Company, a corporation, operates public utility warehouses at Atascadero, Garden Grove, Lanare and Riverdale. It seeks authority to discontinue service and to cancel its rates:

The verified application alleges that applicant was organized by the Poultrymen's Cooperative Association of Southern California primarily to handle and store the latter's poultry feed; that in more than ten years of operation the public has made very little use of applicant's facilities; and that there has been virtually no public storage during the last several years. Applicant points out that other warehousemen maintain public storage facilities in the areas involved.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Producers Warehouse Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue public utility warehouse service; and that, concurrently with the discontinuance of its operations, and on not less than five (5) days' notice

to the Commission and to the public, it shall cancel rates, rules and regulations applicable thereto.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof,
