O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Stevenson and Johnson Streets in Visalia, Tulare County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings Nos. ~~BAC-252.5~~ ^{BAC-252.5} and ~~BAC-252.6~~ ^{BAC-252.6}, respectively. S.P.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) at Stevenson Street and by one additional Std. No. 1 crossing sign at Johnson Street.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
