Decision No. 38992

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of SAN DIEGO & ARIZONA EASTERN RAILWAY COMPANY, for an order authorizing the construction of grade of an industry spur track upon and along "L" Street and crossing 13th Street, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California.

O.R.D.E.R.

San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 13th Street in San Diego, San Diego County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 36-1.45-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection at the crossing shall be provided by a member of the train crew acting as flagman.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
