ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pacific Motor Trucking Company by the above entitled application requests an order of this Commission revoking the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to it by Decision No. 34732 in Third Supplemental Application No. 18699, which authorized it to operate a highway common carrier service to and from Lemoore Airport.

The Airport was active during the war and applicant rendered the necessary service thereto. Since the war has ended the Airport has been abandoned as a military establishment and highway common carrier service is not needed now.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company by Decision No. 34732, in Third Supplemental Application No. 18699, is revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall within 30 days from the date hereof and on not less than one day's notice to

the Commission and the public, issue appropriate supplements of cancellation to its tariffs and time tables.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
