ORDER

The County of Orange is authorized to widen an existing crossing (Crossing No. 2-201.0) over the tracks of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company at Doheny Park. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two (2) feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than fifty (50) feet and grades of approach shall be identical with those at the present crossing. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Frotection shall be by existing protective devices, which shall be relocated so as to conform with the provisions of G.O. No. 75-B.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
