SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY and THE WESTERN PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY are authorized to construct a side track at grade across 98th Avenue in Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-13.3. Applicants shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and not lower than three inches below those of the adjacent main line and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. No additional protection is required.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicants shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessary or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
