INTERIM ORDER

By Decision No. 37931, a certificate was issued to Pete Drake authorizing passenger stage service between Terminal Island and Long Beach. By the terms of the order, this certificate terminates one year from the effective date of said Decision No. 37931 unless further time is granted by subsequent order. The decision was dated May 24, 1945, and made effective 20 days thereafter.

On April 19, 1946, Pete Drake filed a fourth supplemental application requesting the Commission to make said Decision No. 37931 permanent.

Inasmuch as it appears that a public hearing is necessary to decide the issues involved, applicant, by an amendment to fourth supplemental application, filed May 18, 1946, has requested that the termination date of the authority above referred to be extended to August 31, 1946.

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that paragraph (1)(c) of part I of the order of Decision No. 37931 is amended to read:

"(c) That the authority granted by the foregoing certificate shall terminate on August 31, 1946, unless further time is granted by subsequent order."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said Decision No. 37931 shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be 10 days from the date hereof.
