By the above entitled application, applicant requests that the Commission issue to him a new certificate of public convenience and necessity in the place and stead of, and embodying the certificates and operative rights which he now holds. ORDER

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- (1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to A. W. Way, authorizing operations as a highway common carrier, as defined in Section 2-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act, between South San Francisco; San Francisco; Oakland, Petaluma, Santa Rosa, Villits and all points Villits to Arcata (both inclusive) including Garberville, Scotia, Alton, Ferndale, Fernbridge, Fortuna and Eureka; for the transportation of the following named commodities and subject to the following limitations as to specific points:
 - a. From South San Francisco, San Francisco, to Garberville, Arcata and all intermediate points, including
 Eureka, Loleta, Ferndale, Fernbridge, Fortuna, Alton
 and Scotia, cream, butter, all cheese, eggs (except
 hatching eggs), meat and meat products (edible, except
 canned goods), edible oils, draught beer, fresh vegetables, fresh fruits, dressed poultry.

 To South San Francisco, San Francisco from Garberville,
 Arcata and all intermediate points including Eureka,
 Loleta, Ferndale, Fernbridge, Fortuna, Alton and
 Scotia, cream, butter, all cheese, eggs (except hatching eggs), fresh vegetables and fresh fruit.
 - b: From South San Francisco, San Francisco to Willits, meat and meat products (edible, except canned goods), edible oils.

 To South San Francisco, San Francisco from Arcata and Eureka, meat and meat products (edible, except canned goods).
 - From Santa Rosa to Eureka and Fernbridge, eggs (except hatching eggs), draught beer, dressed poultry.

 To Santa Rosa from Eureka and Fernbridge, eggs (except hatching eggs), dressed poultry, cream, butter, all cheese.
 - d: From Petaluma to Eureka, eggs (except hatching eggs), dressed poultry.

 To Petaluma from Eureka, eggs (except hatching eggs):

- From Arcata, Eureka, Ferndale, Fernbridge, and Scotia to Santa Rosa Oakland, San Francisco, South San Francisco, fresh meat.
- That the foregoing certificate is not granted in addition to applicant's present operative rights but in the place and stead thereof, and all highway common carrier operative rights now held by applicant, including those created by Decision No. 27694, dated January 21, 1935; and Decision No. 38742, dated March 5, 1946, are hereby revoked and annulled:
- (3) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:
 - Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed 30 days from the effective date hereof.
 - Applicant shall conduct highway common carrier b. operations pursuant to the certificate herein granted over and along the following routes:

Over and along U. S. Highway 101 between Arcata and South San Francisco, serving Ferndale by diversion over the public highway from Fernbridge; over U. S. Highway 50 between San Francisco and Oakland; over an alternate route between San Rafael and Oakland via the San Rafael-Richmond Ferry and U.S. Highway 40.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
