OPINION AND ORDER

H. K. Willard is the owner and operator of a public utility warehouse situated at Red Bluff and known as "Willard's Warehouse." By this application, Willard seeks authority to sell his warehouse property to Poultry Producers of Central California, a corporation, for a cash consideration of \$30,000. The corporation proposes to lease the property to Paul G. Sholz. Sholz, who operates public warehouses under lease from Poultry Producers at other points in northern California, will continue to provide public storage service at Red Bluff at the same rates as those now maintained by Willard.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that H. K. Willard, doing business as Willard's Warehouse, be and he is hereby authorized to sell the public utility property involved in this proceeding to Poultry Producers of Central California, a corporation, in accordance with the terms of the agreement attached to the application as Exhibit "B"; that the purchaser be and it is hereby authorized to lease such property to Paul G. Sholz, in accordance with the terms

of the agreement attached to the application as Exhibit "D"; and that Paul G. Sholz, concurrently with the commencement of warehouse operations at the location here involved, shall file rates, rules and regulations identical with those now maintained by H. K. Willard, in conformity with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs as set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61 and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
