ORDER

By this supplemental application, Los Angeles Transit Lines request permission to make a slight extension of its Alvarado Street Motor Coach Line No. 41, in order to provide a connection with motor coach service which it proposes to operate on Adams Boulevard, as a substitute for "A" Rail Line service, pursuant to the authority granted by Decision No. 33984, dated March 11, 1941, on Application No. 23902 and 38th Supplemental Application No. 19179. Applicant alleges that the proposed extension can be operated without the use of additional equipment and that no change in fares or regulations will be involved. Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the route description of applicant's Alvarado Street Motor Coach Line No. 41, contained in Decision No. 36291, dated April 13, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of West Adams Boulevard and Hoover Street, thence via West Adams Boulevard, 25th Place, Hoover Street, Alvarado Street, and Glendale Boulevard to the intersection of Glendale Boulevard and Scott Avenue; return via Glendale Boulevard, Montana Street, Alvarado Street, and Hoover Street to West Adams Boulevard, the point of commencement.

This authorization is subject to the following conditions:

1. Said service shall commence within a period not to exceed six (6) months from the effective date of this order.

- 2. Notices shall be placed in the equipment of applicant, giving the public at least five (5) days' notice in advance of the inauguration of the new extension.

In all other respects Decision No. 36291 shall remain in full force and effect. This order shall be effective immediately.
