ORDER

Escalon Packers, Inc. is authorized to construct a private crossing at grade across the main line and passing tracks of Tidewater Southern Railway Company at its plant in Escalon, San Joaquin County. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than four per cent. Said crossing shall be protected by a Standard No. 1 Crossing Sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

As soon as materials are available, but not later than six months from the opening of said crossing, applicant shall provide a gate across the roadway leading to the crossing, which shall be kept closed and locked during periods when the plant of applicant is not in operation. Within one year from the date of this order applicant shall close the existing private crossing located approximately 200 feet from the crossing herein authorized and Tidewater Southern Railway Company is hereby authorized to remove said crossing at that time unless further time be granted by subsequent order of this Commission.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
