ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 37017, dated April 25, 1944, Edward A. Miller was granted a certificate to provide a passenger stage service between Martinez and Richmond Shipyards Nos. 2 and 3 and intermediate points subject to certain restrictions.

Under date of April 29, 1946, Miller informed the Commission as follows:

"This is to inform you that the operation from Martinez to Richmond has been abandoned, and I desire the same to be revoked."

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the operative right granted by Decision No. 37017 is hereby revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
