O P I N I O N

In this application Ray Herndon requests a license to engage in the business of a motor carrier transportation agent, as defined in the Motor Carrier Transportation Agent Act (Ch. 390, Stats. 1933, as amended). A hearing was held at Los Angeles before Examiner Gannon on June 6, 1946.

Applicant operates as a motor carrier transportation agent at 40 South Los Robles Avenue, Pasadena, California, having been duly licensed by the Commission in Decision No. 37502, rendered November 28, 1944. For some years he has been in the employ of the California Institute of Technology at Pasadena as engineer in charge of the heating plant at said Institute. In this application he seeks a license to operate at 4122 South Broadway, Los Angeles, in conjunction with his operations at Pasadena. Until such time as he can find a qualified associate to take charge of the Los Angeles office, he would himself assume the management of that office. The Pasadena office is operated during his absence by Mrs. Jane Pretlow who is

From the record herein we are of the opinion and find that applicant is qualified to receive a license as a motor carrier transportation agent at the address stated above and it will be so ordered.

O R D E R

A public hearing having been held in the above entitled proceeding, evidence having been received, the matter having been submitted and the Commission now being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that Ray Herndon be and he is hereby licensed to engage in the business or act in the capacity of a motor carrier transportation agent, as defined in the Motor Carrier Transportation Agent Act (Ch. 390, Stats. 1933, as amended), at the following location, to-wit: 4122 South Broadway, Los Angeles, California; to sell, offer for sale, negotiate for, furnish or provide transportation to be furnished by motor carriers, as defined in Chapter 390, Statutes 1933, as amended, subject to the condition, however, that he shall, within 60 days from the date hereof, provide and file with the Railroad Commission a good and sufficient surety bond in the sum of \$1000 in accordance with the provisions of Section 8 of said Act and in a form prescribed or approved by the Railroad Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this license shall expire on December 31, 1946, subject to the provisions for renewal prescribed by the Railroad Commission; provided, however, that his license shall be inoperative and of no force or effect during any period when there shall not be in effect and on file with the Railroad Commission for said Ray Herndon a good and sufficient surety bond in accordance with the provisions of said Section 8 of said Act and the rules and regulations of the Railroad Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon said Ray Herndon filing with the Commission a surety bond as hereinabove provided, the Secretary of the Railroad Commission be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue and deliver to said Ray Herndon a certificate of the authority granted hereby.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above described license be issued upon the condition that operations authorized thereunder shall be conducted in accordance with all applicable rules, regulations and requirements relating thereto issued by the Commission under the Motor Carrier Transportation Agent Act (Ch. 390, Stats. 1933, as amended).

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
