

DECISION NO. 39314

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the application of THE WESTERN PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY for permission to construct, maintain and operate a spur track at grade crossing Indiana Street south of Army Street in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California

ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Indiana Street in San Francisco, at the location described in the application. Said street is not open or improved at the point of crossing and this order shall not be construed as authorizing such opening. Applicant shall beer entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
