ORDER OF REVOCATION

P. H. Grossman was certificated by the Commission (Decision No. 35485) to transport passengers between Pasadena and the California Shipbuilding Yards at Terminal Island, and was also certificated (Decision No. 35842) to transport passengers between Pasadena and the Vultee and the Douglas Aircraft Plants near Downey and Long Beach, respectively.

Under dates of April 5, May 15, and May 20, 1946, Grossman informed the Commission that such service has been discontinued because of a lack of patronage and consents to the revocation of the certificates above referred to.

Therefore and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificates of public convenience

and necessity granted to P. H. Grossman by Decisions Nos. 35485 and 35842 are hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of P. H. Grossman are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
