OPINION

During the recent hostilities Ballard Jenkins was providing a passenger stage service between Indio, Santa Mohica, San Bernardino, Riverside, Palm Springs and other points, on the one hand, and various military training camps and areas situated at various places in the vicinity of Indio, on the other hand. This service was provided pursuant to certificates issued by the Commission, but has been under authorized suspension since June of 1944.

By the above entitled application applicant Jenkins requests authority to abandon all operations and as justification therefor alleges as follows:

The services heretofore conducted by applicant were established during the war and were principally for the transportation of military personnel between military camps on the one hand, and various points in Southern California on the other hand. Activities at all camps have been abandoned, except for a small maintenance force at some camps which do not further require applicant's services.

Due to cessation or suspension of activities at the various camps, applicant has not conducted service over its routes since June, 1944, such service having been suspended under authority of various orders of the Commission and as applicant now believes that the possibility of the camps reopening is very remote, desires to abandon all service formerly conducted by him.

After full consideration, applicant's request, which appears to be reasonable, will be granted. No public hearing is necessary.

ORDER

An application therefor having been filed and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- (1) That Ballard Jenkins is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon passenger stage operations between the points certificated by Decisions Nos. 35291, dated April 27, 1942; 35822, dated October 6, 1942; 36738, dated November 24, 1943; 36778, dated December 21, 1943, and 36960, dated March 28, 1944.
- (2) That the certificates of public convenience and necessity granted by the decisions referred to in paragraph (1) of this Order are hereby revoked and annulled.
- (3) That all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Ballard Jenkins are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof. λ
