O R D E R

In this supplemental application Key System, a corporation, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an occasional motor coach route to serve Woodminster Memorial Park, Oakland at times only when special events are in progress at the amphitheater of said park. Applicant alleges that the Park Department of the City of Oakland has requested it to perform this special event service. It will involve a short extension to a portion of Applicant's No. 77 Piedmont Pines motor coach line as presently operated.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it is hereby granted to Key System, a corporation, as a passenger stage corporation as defined in Section 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Public Utilities Act for the transportation of passengers between the intersection of El Barranca and Mountain Boulevard and the entrance to Woodminster Memorial Park, a distance of approximately 1,300 feet as an extension of and to be consolidated with this present operation as subject to the following conditions:

1. Written acceptance of the certificate herein granted shall be filed within a period of not to exceed 30 days from the date hereof.
2. Service shall commence within a period of not to exceed 90 days from the effective date hereof.
3. Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify such at any time by further order said passenger stage operation can be conducted along the following described route:

Commencing at the intersection of
El Serranocal and Mountain Boulevard
thence Mountain Boulevard and Joaquin
Miller Road to the entrance of Wood-
minster Memorial Park.

4. This service is to be operated as an occasional
service when special events are being held in
the amphitheater at said Woodminster Memorial
Park.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
