izing the construction, maintenance
and operation of an industry spur track
across Madison Street in the County of
Los Angeles, State of California.

ORIGINAL

Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, and its lessee,
Union Pacific Railroad Company, are authorized to construct an indus-
trial spur track across Madison Street in Los Angeles County, at the
location described in the application. Madison Street is not now
actually constructed and open to travel at the point of crossing, and
this order is not an authorization for the construction of said Madi-
son Street to public use across said tracks. The tracks shall be so
constructed that grades of approach not exceeding 3% will be feasible
in the event that the construction or opening of Madison Street across
said tracks shall hereafter be authorized.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order,
applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authori-
zation shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time
be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authori-
zation may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or
safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
