FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

For the reasons set forth in Decision No. 35320 of May 5, 1942, in this proceeding, applicant was authorized to deviate from the minimum rates otherwise applicable to the transportation of bakery goods. This authority is limited to a routed delivery service performed for National Biscuit Company and Loose-Wiles Biscuit Company in connection with shipments originating in San Francisco and Oakland and destined to points in those cities and to various other points along designated routes extending to Willits, Calistoga, Suisun-Fairfield, Tracy and San Jose. This authority expires July 11, 1946. By supplemental application a one-year ex-¹ tension of this authority at increased rates is sought.

The verified supplemental application shows that since this authority was considered a year ago applicant has experienced certain higher operating costs; that the increased rates proposed will compensate for these greater costs; that operations under the proposed rates will be compensatory; and that the authority sought is necessary to retain the traffic in for-hire transportation

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Applicant proposes to increase the authorized rate of 35 cents per 100 pounds, minimum aggregate weight 3,812 pounds, to 40 cents per 100 pounds, minimum aggregate weight 5,250 pounds. It also proposes to increase the mileage rate of 7 cents per mile for mileage traveled in excess of 50 miles per trip to 10 cents per mile.


It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the supplemental application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Walkup Drayage Company be and it is hereby authorized to transport bakery goods, viz.: biscuits, cookies, crackers, matzos, pretzels and toast, for National Biscuit Company and Loose-Wiles Biscuit Company from San Francisco and Oakland to points within the area embraced by Application No. 24949, filed April 27, 1942, at rates less than the established minimum rates but not less than the basis of rates set forth in said application, as amended, in the fourth supplemental application filed June 27, 1946, plus a charge which reflects payments to drivers for one week's vacation; and that this authority shall expire one year from the effective date hereof, unless sooner changed, canceled or extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective July 11, 1946.
