O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct industrial tracks at grade across San Diego Avenue and Hamilton, Fulton, Anna, Bralley, and Woodward Streets in Fresno, Fresno County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified and protected as follows:

<u>Street Crossed</u>	<u>Crossing No.</u>	<u>Protection</u>
Two additional side tracks (tracks 1 and 2) across the intersection of San Diego Ave., Hamilton Street, Fulton Street and Anna Street.	Portion of Crossing No. BS-206.5	One Std. No. 3 Wigwag and three Std. No. 1 Crossing Signs.
Two spur tracks (tracks 3 and 5) across portions of Anna Street north of Bralley Street.	BS-206.62-C	Two Std. No. 1 Crossing signs.
One lead track (track 1); four spur tracks (tracks 3, 4, 5, and 6) across Bralley Street.	BS-206.65-C	Two Std. No. 1 Crossing Signs
One spur track (track 7) across a portion of Anna Street south of Bralley St.	BS-206.69-C	One Std. No. 1 Crossing sign.
One lead track (track 1) across Woodward Street.	BS-206.73-C	Two Std. No. 1 Crossing signs.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
