ORDER

The City of Stockton is authorized to construct an extension of East Miner Avenue at grade across tracks of Central California Traction Company and Stockton Terminal and Eastern Railroad in that City, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings No. 61-1.4 and 41-18.7-C, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails of each crossing. The respective railroad companies shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than that of the traveled portion of the street and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign at each crossing (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
