ORDER

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across California Avenue near Fresno, Fresno County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BC-207.64-C. Upon completion Crossing No. 207.68-C across said road shall be removed. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public conventence, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
