BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of Application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of railroad industrial spur track across Drake and Wave Streets, in the City of Monterey, County of Monterey, State of California.) Application No. 27616)

ORIGINAL

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Drake Street and across Wave Street in Monterey, Monterey County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings Nos. EE-126.6 and EE-126.7.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways and with grades of approach substantially the same as existing grades. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
