BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of the County of Fresno, State of California, for permission to abandon the existing crossing on Olive Avenue across the right of way and tracks of the main lines of the Southern Pacific Company, and for permission to construct and maintain a crossing at grade across the right of way and tracks of said main lines of the Southern Pacific Company at a new location of said Olive Avenue a short distance north of the said existing crossing.

First Supplemental Order

In Decision No. 32443 in the above application the County of Fresno was authorized to relocate a crossing of Olive Avenue with the main line track of Southern Pacific Company near the northerly limits of Fresno. This area has now been annexed to the City of Fresno and the city requests amendment to the decision authorizing it to perform the work instead of Fresno County.

Good Cause Appearing IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the City of Fresno is authorized to construct the crossing of Olive Avenue heretofore authorized in Decision No. 32443 subject to the conditions of that decision. This authority is extended to and including October 10, 1947. In all other respects said Decision No. 32443 is in full force and effect.
