In the matter of the application of Southern Pacific Company for an order to abolish a crossing of a publicly used road by a railroad in Glenn County, California.

O R D E R

In this application Southern Pacific Company requests authority to abolish by physical closing a publicly used road in Glenn County, California. The Board of Supervisors of said county have passed a resolution to the effect that it will not oppose the closing of this crossing.

Good Cause Appearing IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abolish by physical closing a publicly used grade crossing located about .7 of a mile south of applicant's station of Artois and identified as Crossing No. AE-155.1.

Within thirty days thereafter applicant shall notify the Commission in writing the closing of said crossing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
