FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 39016 in this application The Western Pacific Railroad Company was authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 24th Street and a portion of Tennessee Street in San Francisco. It now develops that said streets are not open to public use at the point of crossing and that said decision should be modified, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first paragraph of Decision No. 39016 is modified to read as follows:

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 24th Street and a portion of Tennessee Street in San Francisco at the location described in the application. Said streets are not open to public travel at the point of crossing and this order shall not be construed as authorizing such opening. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

In all other respects said decision is in full force and effect.
