## CPINICI

By Docision No. 38665, dated February 5, 1946, applicant F. M. Snell was authorized to establish a passenger stage service between the intersection of Base Line Street and County Hospital Drive, in the City of San Bernardine, and the intersection of Pacific and Dol Rosa Avenues, in the County of San Bernardine, and also between the intersection of Base Line Street and Mountain View Avenue and the intersection of E Street and 4th Street, in the City of San Bernardine, as an extension and enlargement of applicant's existing rights and subject to a cortain restriction not material to this application.

Service as authorized has been established and applicant now seeks authority to further extend his operations from the present terminus at the intersection of Pacific and Del Rosa Avenues, a distance of approximately two miles in a southeasterly direction, so as to provide bus transportation principally for persons residing along 9th Street between Golondrina and McKinley Streets.

The proposed extension will provide convenient transportation for many residents of a large subdivision located
on either side of 9th Street, an area not now being served. The
service has been requested by several hundred residents of this
community.

Applicant states that half-hour schedules are proposed during the morning and afternoon peak periods with an hourly headway during the remainder of the day. Service will be operated approximately between 7:30 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. Applicant's present service along Base Line Street, east of Colondrina Street, is now on a 30-minute headway. The proposed route (inbound) along Base Line Street will result in a 15-minute service between Golondrina and McKinley Streets, thereby affording some relief from crowded bus conditions during morning and evening peak periods.

The proposed extension will not require additional equipment and is entirely within applicant's present ll-cent fare zone.

The matter having been fully considered, we find the proposed service to be in the public interest and, therefore, the application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

## <u>ORDER</u>

Application having been made in the above-entitled matter, and the Commission being fully advised and finding that

public convenience and necessity so require,

## IT IS CRDERED:

- (1) That a certificate of public convenience and nocessity be and it is hereby granted to F. M. Snoll, an individual,
  doing business as San Bernardine-Highland-Patten Motor Ceach
  Line, authorizing the establishment and operation of a service
  as a "passenger stage corporation", as defined by Section 2%
  of the Public Utilities Act, between the intersection of Pacific
  and Del Rosa Avenues and the intersection of McKinley and Base
  Line Streets, and intermediate points, as an extension of and
  to be consolidated with the passenger stage operations now conducted by said F. M. Snoll.
- (2) That in the operation of said passenger stage service applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:
  - (a) Applicant shall file a writton acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective date hereof.
  - (b) Applicant shall, within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and upon not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public, establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.
  - (c) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or medify it at any time by further order, applicant shall conduct said passenger stage operations over and along the following route:

Beginning at the intersection of Pacific and Del Rosa Avenues, thence along Pacific Avenue, Alamo Street, Base Line Street, Golondrina Street, 9th Street, McKinley Street to its intersection with Base Line Street.

Applicant is authorized to turn his motor vehicles at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, or in accordance with local traffic rules.
