ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to relocate an exist-  
 ing side track at grade across 68th Avenue in Oakland, Alameda County,  
 at the location described in the application, to be identified as a  
 portion of Crossing No. DH-17.03-C. Applicant shall bear entire con-  
 struction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing  
 shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without  
 super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street  
 now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of  
 approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two  
 Standard No. 2 crossing signs new in place.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order  
 applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authoriza-  
 tion shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time  
 be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-  
 tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or  
 safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
