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FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In compliance with the provisions of Condition (6) of the Order in Decision No. 38174, the Department of Public Works of the State of California has filed with this Commission plans for the signals at the crossing of Hobson Avenue (Crossing No. 6LD-2,78) and the crossing of Foote Avenue (Crossing No. 6LD-2,97) at grade across the tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company.

It appears that the protection proposed in said plans is reasonable and should be approved, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the plans for signals for the protection of the crossing of Hobson Avenue over the tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company (Crossing No. 6LD-2,78) (Drawing No. AE-12296-a), and the crossing of Foote Avenue at grade over the tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company (Crossing No. 6LD-2,97) (Drawing No. AE-12349-a), filed with the Commission June 25, 1946, are hereby approved.

The authority herein granted shall become effective immediately.
