ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to raise and re-locate an industrial spur track across First Street in the City of Fillmore, Ventura County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. First Street is not improved at the point of crossing, and this authority shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street across the spur track.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
