ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

It appearing that by Decision No. 37068, dated May 23, 1944, in the above-numbered application, TWENTYNINE PALMS TRANSPORTATION COMPANY, a wholly-owned and operated subsidiary of Twentynine Palms Air Academy, a corporation, was granted a passenger stage certificate between the Air Academy and Twentynine Palms; that about September, 1944, Twentynine Palms Transportation Company discontinued service without authority of the Commission and has not since resumed such service; that on December 28, 1944, R. E. Allen was appointed receiver for Twentynine Palms Air Academy and all its holdings; that no annual or other reports of the operations of said carrier have been filed with the Commission; therefore, good cause appearing, it is found that Twentynine Palms Transportation Company is no longer conducting and has abandoned said passenger stage service, and therefore

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate granted by said Decision No. 37068 be and it hereby is revoked, and all schedules and tariffs on file cancelled; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service thereof in the manner provided by law, unless said Twentynine Palms Transportation Company or its duly authorized representative, before such ef-

fective date, shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
