ORDER INSTITUTING INVESTIGATION
AND REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT.

ORIGINAL

It appearing that EVERETT LAMPSON has heretofore conducted a seasonal passenger stage service, under the name of Lampson Stage Lines, between Geyserville and Skaggs Springs, evidenced by a tariff showing passenger fares between said points, filed April 21, 1917; it further appearing that said service was discontinued and abandoned in 1944, without authority of the Commission, and that the carrier has consented to the revocation of the operative right therefor; it further appearing that no report of said carrier's operations was filed for the year 1945; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that an investigation be and it is hereby instituted by the Commission, on its own motion, for the purpose of determining whether or not the operative right held by Everett Lampson to conduct a seasonal passenger stage service between Geyserville and Skaggs Springs, should be revoked for unauthorized abandonment.

It being found that said Everett Lampson has discontinued and abandoned the stage service described herein, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative right of Everett Lampson to conduct a seasonal passenger stage service between Geyserville and Skaggs Springs be and the same is hereby revoked.

for unauthorized abandonment, and tariffs and time tables on file cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service thereof in the manner provided by law, unless said Everett Lampson, before such effective date, shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
