Evelyn M. Knapp and John P. Demeter by the above entitled application request authority to use additional routes when rendering passenger stage service between Palo Alto and Menlo Park.

Applicants, who own Palo Alto City Lines, were authorized by Decision No. 38190 in Application No. 25563 to serve between Palo Alto and Menlo Park. The routes they were authorized to use by such decision were amended subsequently by Decision No. 38435 in the same application.

It is proposed that the additional routes be consolidated with those now followed in order to give a more complete and convenient service to residents of Palo Alto and Menlo Park.

The new routes requested are short and will not result in a change of applicants' existing fares or time schedules.

This request appears to be in the public interest and will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Evelyn M. Knapp and John P. Demeter may operate over and along University Drive from its intersection with Santa Cruz Avenue to its intersection with Cambridge Avenue in Menlo Park, and over and along Lytton Avenue from its intersection with Alma Street to its intersection with Emerson Street, thence along the latter to University Avenue, thence along the latter to Alma Street in Palo Alto, in addition to and in consolidation with the routes they were authorized to use between Palo Alto and Menlo Park by Decision No. 38190 in Application No. 25563, as amended by Decision No. 38435 in the same application.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
