FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

James B. Cochran, the applicant herein, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operation of a seasonal common carrier vessel service, as defined in Sections 2(1) and 2(y) of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between the City of San Diego and Avalon, Santa Catalina Island.<sup>(1)</sup>

Due to the intervention of the war, the lack of proper housing facilities at Avalon, and other circumstances beyond his control, applicant was unable to establish and operate the service. His certificate, however, was never revoked and remains in full force and effect.

Pending the completion of plans for the housing of guests at Avalon Terminal, effective in the spring of 1947, applicant requests that inauguration of the service authorized be deferred until the second Saturday in May, 1947, and continue through the third Sunday in September 1947. An order to that effect will be issued.
