O R D E R

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY is authorized to relocate a spur track at grade across Irwin and Seventh Street in San Francisco, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-0.89. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 4 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways, and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two additional Standard No. one crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
