BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of
 PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, a
 corporation, for an order of the
 Railroad Commission of the State of
 California, granting and conferring upon
 applicant all necessary permission and
 authority to consummate, in accordance
 with its terms, a written agreement
 with EL DORADO IRRIGATION DISTRICT,
 dated July 10, 1946 (Exhibit "A"
 hereof).

O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company asks authority to enter into an agree-
ment with El Dorado Irrigation District providing for the sale of excess water for
irrigation usage during the 1946 season.

In this agreement the company proposes to deliver to the district up to
five second feet; or 200 miner's inches⁽¹⁾ of water, in excess of the district's
present contract entitlement to 40 second feet of water, as such excess water may
from time to time be available therefor in the company's El Dorado Canal during a
period ending September 1, 1946, at the rate of 33-1/3¢ per miner's inch day of
24 hours. El Dorado Irrigation District has entered into an agreement with said
company to the effect that the latter will seek the approval of the Commission for
the delivery of said excess water.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is
necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation,
be and it is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the El Dorado

Note: (1) A miner's inch, for the purpose of this agreement, shall mean 1.5
cubic feet of water per minute.

Irrigation District providing for the sale and delivery of excess water to said district substantially in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein and which is hereby made a part of this Order by reference.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with the Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of this agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
