BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of Application of SACRAMENTO CITY LINES for authority to (a) change, alter and amend certain of its present motor coach lines and discontinue permanently use of all of its electric street railway lines and substitute motor coach service therefor, and (b) for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to cover all of its motor coach operations over routes applied for herein, situated in or near the City of Sacramento, in lieu of the certificates presently outstanding.

## INTERIM OPINION

In this proceeding Sacramento City Lines requests authority to amend certain of its motor coach routes, discontinue the use of all electric street rail lines, and for a certificate to cover all of its motor coach routes applied for in its application.

At the hearing on August 22, 1946, both applicant and the City of Sacramento requested that an interim order be issued extending the No. 2 Riverside Boulevard Line into William Land Park at an early date without waiting for determination in the entire matter.

It is the desire of the city that this extension be immediated by established on Saturdays, Sundays, and helidays in order that visitors may reach the zee and playgrounds in said William Land Park.

It appears that the request is reasonable and should be granted without waiting a determination in the entire rerouting plan for the City of Sacramento, and it will be so ordered.

## INTERIM ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

I. A cortificate of public convenience and necessity be and it is hereby granted to Sacramento City Lines, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined by Section 2% of the Public Utilities Act, for

a rercuting and extension of its Riverside Boulevard and Land Park Drive Route No. 2, as an extension and enlargement of its existing certificates, upon and along the following described route:

From the intersection of Riverside Boulevard and 11th Avenue, thence along Riverside Boulevard to 13th Avenue, along 13th Avenue to Cavanaugh Way, along Cavanaugh Way to Bartley Drive, and along Bartley Drive to a terminal at the intersection of Bartley Drive and West Land Park Drive.

II. In previding service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulation:

Applicant shall file a written accoptance of the cortificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective date hereef.
