In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing it to reclassify its Class "A" non-agency station of Narlon to a Class "E" non-agency station.

ORDER

The verified expplication of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Narlon during the past year and that continued maintenance of a Class "A" station at this point is no longer warranted.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Narlon, County of Santa Barbara, as a Class "E" station at which passengers, but no freight, will be handled; to change its station records accordingly; and to cancel all freight tariffs applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

within thirty days after such reclassification is put into effect applicant shall so notify the Commission in writings. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
