ORDER OF REVOCATION

By its 13th Supplemental Application in this proceeding, Pacific Motor Trucking Company, requests a revocation of the certificate granted to it by Decision No. 37304, rendered August 29, 1944, authorizing a highway common carrier service between Vernalis and Vernalis Field. According to the application, all operations at Vernalis Field have been discontinued by the United States Navy and the field has been abandoned. For some time past, applicant has conducted no service between Vernalis and Vernalis Field, and in view of its abandonment, a public transportation service no longer will be required. Under the circumstances the certificate should be revoked. This is not a matter requiring a public hearing.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- (1) That Pacific Motor Trucking Company is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon operation as a highway common carrier, as defined by Section 2-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act,

between Vernalis and Vernalis Field.

(2) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing such operation granted by Decision No. 37304, dated August 29, 1944, is hereby revoked and annulled.

(3) That applicant shall file appropriate supplements to its tariffs and time tables in triplicate, within 60 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the public showing the discontinuance of service as herein authorized.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
