OPINION AND ORDER

This application shows that Marie J. Sagehorn, as administratrix of the estate of Gloria Johanson, deceased; has made arrangements to sell properties formerly belonging to said Gloria Johanson, including a small public utility water system known as the Macdoel Water Works, to George A. Gerber and Martha L. Gerber.

It appears that the water system is an integral part of certain hotel and tavern properties located at Macdoel, Siskiyou County. According to reports filed with the Commission, it serves fifteen consumers and produced operating revenues of \$426 in 1944 and \$452 in 1945. The approximate value of the water system equipment is stated in the application at \$500.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the request to transfer properties should be granted, as herein provided, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as Collows:

- of Gloria Johanson, deceased, after the effective date hereof and on or before November 30, 1946, may sell and transfer to George A. Gerber and Martha L. Gerber the water properties comprising the Macdoel Water Works, referred to herein.
- 2. George A. Gerber and Martha L. Gerber shall, within thirty (30) days after acquiring the aforesaid water system, file a notice with the Commission showing that they will adopt as their own the rates, rules and regulations now on file with the Commission covering service given by said Macdoal Water Works.
- 3. George A. Gerber and Martha L. Gerber shall file with the Commission, within thirty (30) days after they acquire said properties, a statement showing the exact date upon which they acquired and commenced operating the Macdoel Water Works and a copy of the instrument of conveyance.
- 4. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
- 5. The authority herein granted is not to be construed to be a finding of value of the properties herein authorized to be transferred.
