BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

for an order authorizing (a) the
abandonment of its Class "B" Station
of Millford, in the County of Humboldt,
State of California, and (b) the abandon-
ment and removal of applicant's portion
of railroad spur track located at said
station.

O R D E R

The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Com-
pany discloses that no passenger or freight business has been trans-
acted at applicant's station of Millford for more than one year and
that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is
authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Millford, County of
Humboldt; to remove a spur track approximately 140 feet in length at
said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and
to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on
not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facili-
ties, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission
in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised
within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be
effective immediately.
