ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 34275, dated June 3, 1941, in Application No. 24167, a certificate of public convenience and necessity was granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a highway common carrier between Taft and Taft Airport, and between Maricopa and Taft Airport.

Applicant alleges that

"No truck service has been operated by applicant to Taft Airport for some time past and applicant has been informed and believes that the United States Army has discontinued all operations at Taft Airport and has permanently abandoned said project and applicant will not be required to serve it in the future".

Request is made in the application that the operative right hereinabove referred to be revoked.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted by Decision No. 34275 is hereby revoked and annulled and all tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission affecting said operative right are hereby

cancelled.
