OPINION AND ORDER

A. A. Austerland, an individual doing business as
Farmers Warehouse Company, operates three public utility warehouses
at Hilmar. By this application, he seeks authority to lease the
warehouses and certain designated warehouse equipment to Robert G.
Jurs, for a five-year period. The verified application shows that
Jurs, a son-in-law of Austerland, will operate the warehouses under
the supervision of Austerland until completely familiar with the
operation. No change in tariff rates or service to the public
is proposed.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Good cause appearing;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that A. A. Austerland be and he is hereby authorized to lease the public utility warehouse property involved in this proceeding for a period of five years; and that Robert G. Jurs shall, immediately upon the leasing of the said property, on not less than five (5) days notice to the Commission and to the public, adopt or establish as his own the rates, rules and regulations now maintained by A. A. Austerland, in conformity

with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.
