ORDER OF REVOCATION

IT IS ORDERED that the highway common carrier operative right created by Decision No. 18150, dated March 31, 1927, and acquired by said Hawkins pursuant to the authority of the Commission's Decision No. 24744, dated May 2, 1932, is hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Lee B. Hawkins are hereby cancelled.
